100% Disabled Veteran

Any vehicle, which is purchased by an individual (tribal member) who has been honorably discharged from active service in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States or the Oklahoma National Guard and who has been certified by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, its successor, or the Armed Forces of the United States to be a disabled veteran in receipt of compensation at the one-hundred percent (100%) rate for a permanent disability sustained through military action or accident resulting from disease contracted while in such active service shall be exempt from registration tax.

- The exemption may be claimed on only one (1) vehicle in a consecutive three (3) year period by any single qualifying veteran.
- The exemption applies to motor vehicle only. Boats/Motors do not apply.
- The exemption does not apply to surviving spouses of qualified veterans.

Qualifying Criteria and Documentation

- The qualifying veteran must be listed on the title as an owner of the vehicle.
- The vehicle must have been purchased on or after June 19, 2006.
