**Format:** Scramble

**Tee Assignments:** Red: Ladies and Men 70 years of age and older

White: Men 60 to 69 years of age

Blue: Men 59 years of age and younger

- **Ball will be played one club length from the original spot, NO NEARER THE HOLE. Lie cannot be improved from rough to fairway, away from a hazard, etc.**
- **Free drop from mulched areas, no nearer the hole. Relief will be stance plus one club length.**
- **Out of bounds is defined by white lines, stakes and fences.**
- **Red lines indicate hazards. All native areas are played as lateral hazards.**
- **Maximum of Two (2) putts per hole.**
- **Ties will be broken by comparing scores from Hole #18 and then backwards until the tie is broken.**
- **REMINDER: RECORD YOUR FIRST NINE HOLES PLAYED ON THE FRONT NINE OF THE SCORECARD**
- **At the completion of your round, double check your score with your playing partners, sign and turn your scorecard into the pro shop.**
