I am also fully aware that baby strollers, baby joggers, pushed wheelchairs and wheels of any kind (except competitive wheelchairs in a separate race), animals and head phones are strictly prohibited and I agree not to have them on the course. Furthermore, I agree not to go back on the course after finishing. I am fully aware that allowing someone else to wear my race number, switching race numbers or running under a false name is a fraudulent act and agree not to do this. Knowing these facts, and in consideration of your accepting my entry, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators or anyone else who might claim on my behalf, covenant not to sue, and unconditionally waive and release and discharge the Cherokee Nation, all race officials, sponsors, volunteers, agents, employees, assigns or anyone acting for or on their behalf from any and all claims of liability for death, personal injury or property damage of any kind or nature whatsoever arising out of, or in the course of, my participating in this event whether same be caused by negligence or fault. This release and waiver extends to all claims foreseen or unforeseen, known or unknown. The undersigned further grants full permission to sponsors or agents authorized by them to use any photographs, video tapes, motion pictures, recordings or any other record of this event for any purpose.
