



2018 Clothing Assistance Program

The Cherokee Nation Family Assistance Department is pleased to announce beginning May 21, 2018, the Clothing Assistance Program will begin accepting clothing applications through June 29, 2018. The application can be found on the www.cherokee.org website or can be picked up at any of the Human Services field office locations. Once you fill out the application and have copies of all the requested documents; you can fax in, mail in, walk in, and/or email the application to the main Cherokee Nation Tribal Complex or to any of the field office locations. The application process ends at 5pm on June 29th. All mailed applications must be postmarked no later than June 25th in order to make 5pm deadline on June 29th. The gift cards will be distributed in July to those that have qualified for the 2018 Clothing Assistance program. The approved applicant/or their alternate must bring photo identification to pick up the card(s).

Eligibility Requirements and Required Documents to submit with Application

- Student **MUST** be a Cherokee Nation Citizen – copies of tribal cards
- Student and family must live within the Cherokee Nation Jurisdictional Area – this will be verified by a current utility bill, not older than 30 days, that shows your physical address or service address that you will include with your application.
- Student must be in grades K – 12 for the upcoming school year. Pre-K is not eligible for this program.
- Kindergarten students must be age 5 before 9/01/2018
- Proof of school enrollment for each child (copies of enrollment, letter from school, last semester report card)
- Application must be made by custodial parent or legal guardian & provide copies of ID
- Guardians must provide copies of Letters of Guardianship issued by a District Court. If this documentation is not available, the following will be accepted: proof of residency letter on school letterhead from a school official verifying the said guardian on application is listed as the guardian or a copy of the school enrollment packet that identifies applicant as guardian of child(ren).
- Copies of verification of income for all adults (over 18) in the household (wages, social security, TANF, child support, odd jobs)
- Household must meet income guidelines. Income guidelines are the 2018 National Poverty Income Guidelines plus 25%.
