Farm Truck shall mean pickup, truck, or truck tractor used primarily for agricultural purposes. For purposes of farm truck registration eligibility. "pickup" means a small, light truck with an open back or box used for hauling and designed primarily for the carrying of property, rather than people and "truck" mean a motor vehicle designed or converted primarily for carrying or hauling farm commodities, property, livestock, or equipment, rather than people.

To qualify for farm truck registration, the applicant must provide either a copy of Schedule F of the previous year's Federal Income Tax Return, or an agricultural exemption permit (SMX number) assigned by the Oklahoma Tax Commission.

The permit must be in the name of the vehicle owner/tribal citizen, with the following exceptions:

An agricultural exemption permit may be utilized by the spouse.
