The Cherokee Nation 2018 Plan consists of the following:

1. Maximize the efficacy of priority areas the Cherokee Nation through technical and technical assistance activities that will primarily influence the lower third of individuals and families currently living at or below the poverty line.
2. Maximize participation with organizations that work with youth in predominantly Cherokee communities in order to increase their capacity based on providing the priority youth with new educational and financial based self-sufficiency.
3. Maximize outreach and focus on areas of families by developing financial literacy programs to increase Cherokee communities, work on education on the youth.

The specific types of programs/activities to be funded will include:

1. Financial literacy training and financial literacy support programs.
2. Youth programs that provide personal and community development and personal self-sufficiency.
3. Programs that provide emergency assistance.

The Cherokee Nation shall serve low-income individuals and families that live in the Nation's economy (predominant area). An emphasis shall be placed on areas where a significant number of children and families are living at or below poverty.

The criteria and method for the distribution of funds shall be by identifying community organizations that serve youth in high poverty areas. The Cherokee Nation requests a portion of funds be designated to be administered by the public (non-profit) Community Services of Cherokee Nation, through a board of advisors for certain priority areas not covered by an available organization described above. The funds to be distributed by eligible organization shall depend on the availability of funds, number of participants and the number of beneficiaries the program program would serve.
