



SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

FOR CITIZENS LIVING OUTSIDE OF THE RESERVATION

The Cherokee Nation College Resource Center provides scholarships and services for full-time and part-time undergraduate college students. Students must be a registered Cherokee Nation citizen, verified by the Cherokee Nation Registration. The scholarships are intended to supplement educational needs for those pursuing a degree from an accredited U.S. post-secondary institution determined by the Directory of Higher Education.

The At-Large Undergraduate Scholarship program is for registered Cherokee Nation citizens working toward their first associate's or bachelor's degree. Proprietary institutions are not eligible under this scholarship. All undergraduate applicants must apply for federal financial aid at studentaid.gov prior to applying for a Cherokee Nation scholarship. At-Large citizens must be eligible for the federal Pell Grant to be eligible for the Cherokee Nation At-Large Undergraduate Scholarship.

Community service hours apply. All scholarships are subject to the availability of funding.
