




This supplemental plat, showing Tribal claims in sections 17, 19 and 20. Township 10 North, Range 24 East, is based upon the plats approved November I, 1898, and by examination of the best available evidence of river movements including historic aerial photography and maps. This evidence indicates the river moved southerly and easterly by accretive and erosive processes until 1966 after which the reservoir behind Kerr Dam covered both the upland and the riverbed areas in an avulsive action.
