Entries will be received on Thursday, **August 29**, **2013** from 7:30AM till 6:00PM at the Sequoyah High School, Old Gym, Highway 62, Tahlequah, OK 74464.

Each quilt is registered and numbered separately for maximum security.

PICK Up will start at 5:00 pm on Sunday, **not before**. The signed receipt is required for return of quilt(s) to the owner. No quilt/item will be released until all quilts have been inventoried. Entrants must pick up items or arrange for someone to pick them up. Entry receipts must be presented at the time of pickup.

Sequoyah High School is located approximately 2.5 miles Southeast of Tahlequah, Oklahoma on the South side of US Highway 62

From Tulsa:

Take Muskogee Turnpike from Tulsa to Muskogee, OK. Exit US Highway 62 East at Muskogee, OK. Continue East on Highway 62 to Sequoyah High School

From Oklahoma City:

Take Interstate 40 East from OKC to Muskogee Turnpike. Take Muskogee Turnpike North to Muskogee, OK exit US Highway 62 East at Muskogee, OK. Continue East on Highway 62 to Sequoyah High School
