**Goal: To support activities designed to assist low-income individuals to attain an adequate education.**

Objectives:

- a. Integrate programs in the K-8 public schools to support the transition of middle school students into high school in order to affect the high dropout rate.
- b. Integrate career awareness programs in the K-8 public schools for middle school students.
- c. The program will select eight schools from the following counties for participation: Adair, Cherokee, Delaware, Mayes and Sequoyah.
- d. The program will serve approximately 150 students.
