List of documents needed:

1. Obtain official high school transcripts or GED certificate and/ or college/vo-tech transcripts
2. Submit Documentation of required immunizations (Childhood shot records to present)
3. Obtain an Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) Background Check and FBI back ground check.

 - i. Sex offender
 - ii. Violent crimes

 - i. Two sets of fingerprints will be needed to complete FBI request form
4. Any discrepancies on the OSBI or FBI background check will be an automatic disqualification from the application process.
5. A copy of your blue and white Cherokee Nation Card
6. A copy of your Driver's License and Social Security Card
