



SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

FOR CHEROKEE NATION CITIZENS ACROSS THE UNITED STATES

The Cherokee Nation College Resource Center provides scholarships and services for full-time and part-time undergraduate college students. Students must be a registered Cherokee Nation citizen, verified by Cherokee Nation Registration. The scholarships are intended to supplement educational needs for those pursuing a degree from an accredited U.S. post-secondary institution determined by the Department of Education Scorecard.

The At-Large Undergraduate Scholarship program is for Cherokee Nation citizens living anywhere in the United States working toward their first Associates or Bachelor's degree. Proprietary (for-profit) institutions are not eligible under this scholarship. All undergraduate applicants must apply for federal financial aid at studentaid.gov prior to applying for a Cherokee Nation scholarship.

At-Large citizens must be eligible for the federal Pell Grant to be eligible for the Cherokee Nation At-Large Undergraduate Scholarship.

Community service hours apply. All scholarships are subject to the availability of funding.

APPLICATION PERIOD:

Fall: March 1 – June 15

Spring renewal: October 1 – January 15
