
OFFICE: I.

On the left in the Data warehouse from the black go to tribal the drop down box is Cherokee and then maps. Anyone can go in and look at all of our district maps. If they want to purchase larger maps they can through the CSA office.

After checking mail and postages dates of turnaround time. We will be informing the voters in the press releases about the return of their absentees should be returned as soon as possible.

I would like to insert in the absentee packet asking the voter too properly vote their ballot, execute their affidavit, and put the absentee ballot back in the mail in order for it to be received here on time to be counted.
