Project Description: The Proposed Action considered under this Draft EA is to construct a Safe Haven Village to house victims of domestic violence. The proposed Safe Haven Village would be approximately 5.7 acres in size and would contain eighteen modular buildings for housing victims, one case manager building, one security guard building, and one gatehouse building. An entrance road off of Markoma Drive would also be constructed. The Safe Haven Village would be constructed using existing modular buildings currently located at 17728 South Muskogee Avenue, Tahlequah, Okla 74464. As part of the Proposed Action, the modular buildings would be moved approximately 5.5 miles to the site of the Safe Haven Village and placed upon permanent foundations. Once operational, the Proposed Action would allow the Cherokee Nation to offer safe, long-term housing options for victims of domestic violence.
