The Cherokee Nation hereby announces its intent to utilize funding from the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) to support the Bridges to Hope program—an anti-poverty initiative designed to empower Cherokee Nation citizens in building long-term stability and self-sufficiency.

Bridges to Hope provides participants with tools and guidance in the following areas:

- Education and skill development
- Self-assessment and goal setting
- Planning for financial independence
- Connection to community resources
- Access to supportive services

The Cherokee Nation invites public comments regarding this proposed use of CSBG funds. Feedback from citizens, stakeholders, and community partners is essential to ensure the program reflects the needs and priorities of the Cherokee Nation community.
