On April 4, 2023, Chief Chuck Hoskin, Jr. and Deputy Chief Bryan Warner signed an executive order and announced the creation of the Task Force on the Cherokee Nation Autism Initiative.

At Cherokee Nation, we want to provide a comprehensive and collaborative approach with community partners to advance research, increase awareness and advocate for ensuring equitable access to services and resources, diagnosis, treatment, social care and opportunity.
