

PUBLIC NOTICE - Community Development Block Grant Program for Indian Tribes (ICDBG) Citizen Participation and Comment Process

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has published a Notice of Funding Opportunity for the Community Development Block Grant Program for Indian Tribes (ICDBG). The purpose of the program is the development of viable Indian and Alaska Native communities. Cherokee Nation, in partnership with the Housing Authority of Cherokee Nation, proposes to utilize funding from the ICDBG grant program to implement the Cherry Tree Grow Project for 20 homes for rehabilitation. This grant will only fund households that are not economically feasible to complete the rehabilitation and must be occupied or benefited from low- and moderate-income households.
